10 Rich Man: Purple & Fine Linen

- Exodus 28:They shall take the gold, blue, purple, and scarlet thread, and the fine linen, 6and they shall make the ephod of gold, blue, purple, and scarlet thread, and fine woven linen, artistically worked.
- 31"You shall make the robe of the ephod all of blue.
- 39"You shall skillfully weave the tunic of fine linen thread, you shall make the turban of fine linen, and you shall make the sash of woven work.

11 Rich Man: Ciaphas "High Priest"

- Father's House: Annas, Father-in-Law (High Priest)
- John 18:13 And they led Him away to Annas first, for he was the father-in-law of Caiaphas who was high priest that year.

12 **Poor Man, Sick, Hungry For Crumbs**

- John 12:1-3. Lazarus Home...Then Mary took a pound of very costly oil of spikenard, anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped His feet with her hair. And the house was filled with the fragrance of the oil.
- Matt 26:6 And when Jesus was in Bethany at the house of Simon the leper, 7a woman came to Him having an alabaster flask of very costly fragrant oil, and she poured it on His head as He sat at the table.

13 **Yeshua Mocked The Pharisees**

- Unrighteous: sinners, publicans, tax collectors, sick, Lepers, unclean, gentiles, Burn in torment
- Righteous: Wealthy Pharisees, Priests, Scribes, be blessed of Abraham
 - Torah: Does not teach Torture. Judgement, Punishment, Death
- Abraham had power to resurrect: Send back Lazarus, NOPE!
- 5 Brothers would believe- Moses-Torah & Prophets

14 **For The Glory**

- John 11:6 So, when He heard that he was sick, He stayed two more days in the place where He was
- John 11:17 So when Jesus came, He found that he had already been in the tomb four days

15 **1260 Years (Cycles)= 3 1/2 Milennial Days=70 Jubilees**

16 **4 Days After The Message:Resurrection**

- Message to Abraham (end of 2nd Day)
- 2 Days Later (Yeshuas Resurrection / Lazarus)
- Yeshua waits 2 More days: "I am the resurrection and the life..."
