4 **Ezekiel 16:9-10**

- 16:9-10 "And I washed you in water, and I washed off your blood, and I anointed you with oil. 10 "And I dressed you in embroidered work and gave you sandals of leather. And I wrapped you in fine linen and covered you with silk.

5 **Attached To The Washing**

- Ephesians 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, as Messiah also did love the assembly and gave Himself for it, 26 in order to set it apart and cleanse it with the washing of water by the Word, 27 in order to present it to Himself a splendid assembly, not having spot or wrinkle or any of this sort, but that it might be set-apart and blameless.

6 **Royal Priesthood**

- Exodus 19:5 "And now, if you diligently obey My voice, and shall guard My covenant, then you shall be My treasured possession above all the peoples – for all the earth is Mine – 6 'and you shall be to Me a reign of priests (Royal Priesthood) and a set-apart nation.' Those are the words which you are to speak to the children of Yisra'el."
- 2 Peter 2:5 you also, as living stones, are being built up, a spiritual house, a set-apart priesthood, to offer up spiritual slaughter offerings acceptable to Elohim through יהושע Messiah. ... 9 But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a set-apart nation, a people for a possession,

7 **Starts With Levi**

- Priesthood: All of Israel (1 Law-Native Born / Stranger)
- Levi: Malachi 2:4b-7 "And you shall know that I have sent this command to you, as being My covenant with Lěvi," said יהוה of hosts. 5 "My covenant with him was life and peace, and I gave them to him, to fear. And he feared Me, and stood in awe of My Name. 6 "The Torah of truth was in his mouth, and unrighteousness was not found on his lips. He walked with Me in peace and straightness, and turned many away from crookedness. 7 "For the lips of a priest should guard knowledge, and they seek the Torah from his mouth, for he is the messenger of יהוה of hosts.

8 **A New Dress At Sinai**

- Exodus 28: 39“And you shall weave the long shirt of fine linen, and shall make the turban of fine linen, and you shall make the girdle of woven work.40“And make long shirts for Aharon’s sons. And you shall make girdles for them, and you shall make turbans for them, for esteem and comeliness.41“And you shall put them on Aharon your brother and on his sons with him, and shall anoint them, and shall ordain them, and shall set them apart, and they shall serve as priests to Me.42“And make linen trousers for them, to cover their nakedness, reaching from the waist to the thighs.43“And they shall be on Aharon and on his sons when they come into the Tent of Appointment, or when they come near the slaughter-place to attend in the Set-apart Place, so that they do not bear crookedness and die – a law forever to him, and to his seed after him.

9 **Fine Linen, Clean-Bright (White)**

- Ezekiel 39:27And they made the long shirt of fine linen, the work of a weaver, for Aharon and his sons,28and a turban of fine linen, and the turban ornaments of fine linen, and short trousers of fine woven linen,

10 **No Spot, Wrinkle, Blemish...Eph 5**

- Leviticus 21:1And יהוה said to Mosheh, “Speak to the priests, the sons of Aharon, and say to them: ‘No one is to be defiled for the dead among his people,... 6.’They are set-apart to their Elohim and do not profane the Name of their Elohim, for they bring the fire offerings of יהוה, and the bread of their Elohim, and shall be set-apart. ...8’And you shall set him apart, for he brings the bread of your Elohim, he is set-apart to you. For I, יהוה, setting you apart, am set-apart. ...17”Speak to Aharon, saying, ‘No man of your offspring throughout their generations, who has any defect, is to draw near to bring the bread of his Elohim.

11 **Clothing Continues**

- Armor: Isaiah 59:15And the truth is lacking, and whoever turns away from evil makes himself a prey. And יהוה saw, and it displeased Him that there was no right-ruling.16And He saw that there was no man, and was astonished that there was no intercessor. So His own arm saved for Him, and His righteousness upheld him.17And He put on righteousness as a breastplate, and a helmet of deliverance on His head. And He put on garments of vengeance for clothing, and wrapped Himself with ardour as a

- Ephesians 6:11Put on the complete armour of Elohim, for you to have power to stand against the schemes of the devil.12Because we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against authorities, against the world-rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual matters of wickedness in the heavenlies.13Because of this, take up the complete armour of Elohim, so that you have power to withstand in the wicked day, and having done all, to stand.

13 **A New Dress**

- Ephes 6:14Stand, then, having girded your waist with truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness,15and having fitted your feet with the preparation of the Good News of peace;16above all, having taken up the shield of belief with which you shall have power to quench all the burning arrows of the wicked one.17Take also the helmet of deliverance, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of Elohim,

15 **Importance Of Our Dress**

- Matthew 22:2 “The reign of the heavens is like a man, a sovereign, who made a wedding feast for his son,³ and sent out his servants to call those who were invited to the wedding feast. But they would not come. ...⁷” But when the sovereign heard, he was wroth, and sent out his soldiers, destroyed those murderers, and set their city on fire. ...⁹ Therefore go into the street corners, and as many as you find, invite to the wedding feast! ...¹¹⁻¹³ And when the sovereign came in to view the guests, he saw there a man who had not put on a wedding garment,¹² and he said to him, ‘Friend, how did you come in here not having a wedding garment?’ And he was speechless.¹³ Then the sovereign said to the servants, ‘Bind him hand and foot, take him away, and throw him out into the outer darkness – there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.’¹⁴ “For many are called, but few are chosen.”

16 Dress Determines Who You Are...

- From The Woman to The Bride: Rev 19:7 “Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him praise, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife prepared herself.”⁸ And to her it was given to be dressed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteousneses (Actions) of the set-apart ones.⁹ And he said to me, “Write, ‘Blessed are those who have been called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!’ ” And he said to me, “These are the true words of Elohim.”
