

## It's About The New Wine...

- Luke 5:38 “But new wine is put into fresh wineskins, and both are preserved. 39. And no one, having drunk old wine, immediately desires new wine, for he says, ‘The old is better.’”



## Elohim of Mt. Sinai

- John 6:32 Therefore יהושע said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, Mosheh did not give you the bread out of the heaven, but My Father gives you the true bread out of the heaven.

- 51 “I am the living bread which came down out of the heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, **he shall live forever**. And indeed, the bread that I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world.”



## The Messiah “Anointed”

- Pharisaic Judaism: A King, Ruler, Conqueror, Warrior (Melech DAVID)
- Yeshua: DEATH...Eternal Life
- John 11:25 יהושע said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he dies, he shall live.

## Headed To Tabernacles...

- Matt 16:11-12. How is it that you do not understand that I did not speak to you concerning bread, *but* to beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees?”<sup>12</sup>Then they understood that He did not say to beware of the leaven of bread, but of the teaching of the Pharisees and the Sadducees.
- Peter’s Confession: 16And Shim’on Kěpha answering, said, “You are the Messiah, the Son of the living Elohim.” ( **Elohim of Mt. Sinai** )

## Confession: Belief-Understanding-Rock

- Mt 16:18 And I also say to you that you are Kěpha, and on this rock I shall build My assembly (**Israel - Church**), and the gates of She’ol (**DEATH-Grave**) (**Hades - Hell**) shall not overcome it.
- 21-23From that time יהושע began to show to His taught ones that it was necessary for Him to go to Yerushalayim, and to suffer much from the elders and chief priests and scribes, **and be killed, and to be raised again the third day. (Yeshua is headed for DEATH)** <sup>22</sup>And Kěpha took Him aside and began to rebuke Him, saying, “Be kind to Yourself, Master, this shall not be to You!”<sup>23</sup>But He turned and said to Kěpha, “Get behind Me, Satan! You are a stumbling-block to Me, for your thoughts are not those of Elohim, but those of men.”

## Follow Me...Elohim of Sinai

- Scriptures...16:24 Then יהושע said to His taught ones, "If anyone wishes to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his stake, and follow Me.
- NKJV Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me.
- Hebrew 16:24 And then Yeshua said to His talmudim, "Whoever wants to follow after Me is obligated that he should give up hope for himself, and that he take up his WARP and WOOF and follow Me.

## Woven Cloth (tent), NOT Cross

- Gk .4716 : Stauros (from the base of histemi 2476), a stake or a post, a pole or a cross
- Warp & Woof: The threads in a woven fabric, comprised of the warp (threads running lengthwise) and woof (threads running crosswise) to create the texture of the fabric
- Warp (H8359) shthiy: a fixture the warp in weaving
- Woof (H6154) ereb: the web or transverse threads of cloth
- Lev. 13:47 "And when a garment has an infection of leprosy in it, in a woollen garment or in a linen garment,<sup>48</sup> or in the warp or in the weft (woof) of linen or wool, or in leather or in any leather-work, ...Scriptures 2009

## Follow The Elohim of Sinai

- Numbers 9: 15 And on the day that the Dwelling Place was raised up, the cloud covered the Dwelling Place, the Tent of the Witness. From evening until morning it was above the Dwelling Place like the appearance of fire.<sup>16</sup> Thus it was continually: the cloud covered it by day, and the appearance of fire by night.<sup>17</sup> And whenever the cloud was taken up from above the Tent, after that the children of Yisra'el would depart. And in the place where the cloud dwelt, there the children of Yisra'el would camp.<sup>18</sup> At the mouth of יהוה the children of Yisra'el departed, and at the command of יהוה they camped. They remained camped as long as the cloud dwelt above the Dwelling Place.

- <sup>19</sup>Even when the cloud lingered many days above the Dwelling Place, the children of Yisra'el guarded the Charge of יהוה, and did not depart. <sup>20</sup>And so it was, when the cloud was above the Dwelling Place a few days: according to the mouth of יהוה they camped, and according to the mouth of יהוה they would depart.<sup>21</sup> And so it was, when the cloud dwelt only from evening until morning: when the cloud was taken up in the morning, then they departed. Whether by day or by night, whenever the cloud was taken up, they departed.<sup>22</sup> Whether two days, or a new moon or a year that the cloud lingered above the Dwelling Place to dwell upon it, the children of Yisra'el camped, and did not depart. But when it was taken up, they departed.<sup>23</sup> At the mouth of יהוה they camped, and at the mouth of יהוה they departed. They guarded the Charge of יהוה, at the mouth of יהוה by the hand of Mosheh.

## Not To The Cross, To The Grave (Death)

- John 21:17 He said to him the third time, “Shim'on, son of Yonah, do you love Me?” Kēpha was sad because He said to him the third time, “Do you love Me?” And he said to Him, “Master, You know all, You know that I love You.” יהושע said to him, “Feed My sheep.18 Truly, truly, I say to you, when you were younger you girded yourself and walked where you wished, but when you are old you shall stretch out your hands, and another shall gird you and bring you where *you* do not wish.”19 Now this He said, signifying by what death he would esteem Elohim. And having said this, He said to him, “Follow Me.”

## Putting Off Of This TENT...

- 2 Peter 1:11 for in this way an entrance into the everlasting reign of our Master and Saviour יהושע Messiah shall be richly supplied to you.12 And so I intend to remind you of these *matters* again and again, though you know them and have been established in the present truth.13 But I think it is right, as long as I am in this tent, to stir you up by a reminder,14 knowing that the putting off of my tent is soon, even as our Master יהושע Messiah made clear to me.15 And I shall do my utmost also, to see to it that you always have a reminder of these *matters* after my departure.

## Follow Me...

- Luke 9:57 And it came to be, as they journeyed on the way, that someone said to Him, “Master, I shall follow You wherever You go.”58 And יהושע said to him, “The foxes have holes and the birds of the heaven nests, but the Son of Adam has nowhere to lay His head.”59 And He said to another, “Follow Me,” but he said, “Master, let me first go and bury my father.”60 And יהושע said to him, “Let the dead bury their own dead, but you go and announce the reign of Elohim.”61 And another also said, “Master, I shall follow You, but let me first say good-bye to those in my house.”62 But יהושע said to him, “No one, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the reign of Elohim.”

## Pick up your tent...Follow Me

- Luke 9:24 24 “For whoever wishes to save his life shall lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake shall save it.25 For what is a man profited if he gains all the world, and is himself destroyed or lost?”26 “For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words, of him the Son of Adam shall be ashamed when He comes in His esteem, and in His Father’s, and of the set-apart messengers.27 “But truly I say to you, there are some standing here who shall not taste death at all till they see the reign of Elohim:”
